This is the upcoming schedule for the year. Depending on the level you've joined at, you can choose 1-12 classes. I promise you'll learn sewing skills and features about your machine you never knew existed! Mark your calendar for the 2nd Saturday of every month; 1-3pm!



October 9, 2021 – “Soft Sculpture Pumpkin Patch” – Discounted Kit Optional. Learn how to make these quick and easy stuffed fabric pumpkins, perfect for the Autumn season. I've have created two different patterns & 3 sizes.



November 13, 2021 – “Fold Over Project Tote” – Kit Available; possibly included with your membership. You'll love the vintage vibe of this dual carry tote. This slightly slouchy fold over is reminiscent of a newspaper carrier's bag. You get extra points if you a) remember having a paper carrier, b) were a paper carrier, or c) still get a newspaper delivered on your porch rather than your digital device. Thicker fabric and topstitching detail work together to provide the perfect blend of softness and stability. All the room and pockets will make this the perfect carrier for your Creators Club projects tools and supplies!



December 11, 2021 – “Holiday Tree Wreath Ornament” – This Holiday Tree Wreath ornament is a quick, easy and fun project, perfect for decorating or as a gift. An added bonus – learn how your sewing machine will sew buttons on for you...you'll never do it by hand again!



January 8, 2022 – “Crossback Sewing Apron” – Wearing an apron in your sewing room will save you time & frustration looking for the tools you always need; thread snips, seam ripper, fabric markers, tape measure and more! We'll transform a cotton tea towel with a few simple steps and your sewing machine's accessories. One Size fits most.



February 12, 2022 – “Keepsake Pillow; French Hand Sewing By Machine” – Explore this elegant stitching technique that replicates the exquisite detail of hand-made christening gowns from over 100 years ago. This stitching technique will give you the unique skills to make one of a kind heirloom that will be treasured for years.



March 12, 2022 – “Easy Kaleidoscope Runner” – Cut 4 identical layers of the fabric into strips, and sub-cut them into squares. It's the same process as making a One Block Wonder, only using 4 layers instead of 6, and cutting squares instead of 60 degree triangles! The finished results are exciting and beautiful!



April 9, 2022 – “Oilcloth Coffee Mat” – Turn any of your fabric cotton prints into waterproof, easy to clean oilcloth! Learn how to use a liquid gel provides a waterproof quality and sheen to any fabric or paper. Transparent and odorless, acid-free and solvent-free. Once applied the fabric can be sewn, cut, hand or machine washed.



May 14, 2022 – “Oilcloth Coffee Mat” – Turn any of your fabric cotton prints into waterproof, easy to clean oilcloth! Learn how to use a liquid gel provides a waterproof quality and sheen to any fabric or paper. Transparent and odorless, acid-free and solvent-free. Once applied the fabric can be sewn, cut, hand or machine washed.



June 11, 2022 – “Quilt-As-U-Go Patriotic Topper” – Discounted Kit Optional This Easy Patriotic Table Topper is oh so easy! In fact, you can finish the whole thing in a couple hours! At approximately 18” square, you could use Insul-Bright instead of batting so you could sit hot dishes on it – plenty of room for a 9 x 13 pan!



July 9, 2022 – “Quilt Facings v.s. Binding” – Learn how to create facings on quilts when they are meant to be decorative art to hang on the wall, rather than a functional piece for a bed. Bindings are generally used in traditional functional quilts because they provide a double edge on the quilt that will wear longer.



August 13, 2022 – “Throw Away Fabric Reborn” Have you ever stopped to wonder about that “funky” edge of your printed cotton fabrics – the side you’ve probably cut off before getting started with your project? I’ll show you how exciting that “throw away” fabric can be...start saving your selvages today!



September 10, 2022 – “Pile ‘O Pumpkins Wall Hanging” – Learn to perfect your applique stitching skills! I’ll help you with your machine’s stitches to make your Blanket Stitch truly beautiful or Satin Stitch super smooth. This adorable hanging is ideal for the whole harvest season.



October 8, 2022 – “2 For 1 Plate Cozy” – These 2 for 1 plate cozies are darling, and simple to make! They feature the Pre-cut Plate Cozy batting from The Gypsy Quilter which is microwave safe, with a fun piecing technique. You’ll use them all the time and they make a terrific gift!



November 12, 2022 – “Fancy Folded Star” – Folded patchwork star is made by folding and layering fabrics together, which makes it look like fabric origami. It looks great but complicated to make, however it has a simple technique. The star design looks perfect for place mats, mug rags, potholders or any kind of decoration. It is also great to use your fabric stash.



December 10, 2022 – “Cellphone Wallet” – This convenient cross body wallet holds everything you need! There’s a place for your phone, credit cards & cash. The lining we use will protect your credit cards from thieves that want to steal your info! This will make the perfect gift for everyone on your list and for yourself!
